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A. Introduction

It is generally assumed that modernization has a negative impact on the dominant culture or tradition in society (Surya, Taibe et al. 2022). As a result of the inclusion of modern traditions in society, they are gradually being forgotten as the younger generation adopts advanced technology.

B. Method

This research is classified as a literature study with a qualitative approach. Literature study is a research method that is carried out by seeking information through relevant reading sources such as books, journals, and valuable documents (Arikunto, 2013). In this study, the sources used are national and international

sources. The information obtained will be described using qualitative data analysis techniques, namely by describing it more deeply in the results and discussion section so as to produce a conclusion.

C. Result and Discussion

1. Traditional Society

The word traditional comes from the word tradition which is etymologically this term comes from the Latin word "traditum" which means "from before to now". A traditional society is a society that respects its ancestors and their customs and traditions (Oktavia 2022). In general, a traditional society is a society that believes that it is an obligation, a need and a pride to carry the legacy of its ancestors in the form of values, norms, desires and aspirations in life (Mutiani 2022). Continuing ancestral traditions means maintaining community harmony, but conversely, breaking traditions means destroying community harmony (Prayogi and Rizqi 2022).

Therefore, traditional societies tend to be closed and suspicious of foreign cultural elements which are seen as damaging the harmony of relations between citizens. Every violation of the prevailing values and norms creates a strong reaction from community members, because the social control of community members is very strong. Traditional societies are largely primitive, and when traditions are violated, they face sanctions and ostracism, up to and including deportation (Abdurrahman and Ahmad 2022). Sanctions against indigenous peoples are not only physical punishment.

Traditional communities usually live in remote places to allow the community to preserve their culture from outside cultural influences, such as living in a village, so that some consider traditional society to be synonymous with village communities (Syamsurya 2022). This opinion is not entirely correct because many village communities are now advanced (modern) and the definition of village refers to regional criteria and not merely the environment.

Traditional society is sometimes interpreted as a primitive society, namely a society with weak technology (Herdiana 2022). But in reality, traditional societies such as Japan and England already have high technology, but people still adhere to traditional values. Likewise, several ethnic groups in Indonesia live with advanced (modern) technology on the one hand, but still maintain their traditions

on the other. So the measure of traditional society that is synonymous with primitive society is not quite right.

2. Characteristics of Traditional Society

Traditional society in general has the following characteristics (Syamsurya 2022):

- a. The number of members is relatively small so that the relationship between citizens
- b. Society is strong enough.
- c. Homogeneous society seen from heredity, tradition and maybe eyes
- d. Livelihood.
- e. Has rules that bind community members to obey.
- f. Be closed and tend to be suspicious of foreign cultural elements
- g. Social life tends to progress slowly (static).
- h. Their social mobility is relatively low because they are satisfied with what they have.
- i. The emotional connection with nature where it originates (is born) is very strong, and nature is seen as something terrible and inevitable so that humans must submit to it.
- j. The religious attitude is very strong, namely adherence to something that becomes a belief (religion) is very strong).

3. Modern Society

The modern word is the result of the modernization process. Modernization is a process of change or directed social change from a less advanced or less developed state to a better one, manifested in all aspects with the hope of a more developed, advanced and prosperous life. The term modern then emerged from the term modernization (Rahmawati 2022). Modern is usually associated with something "new" or "new". The modern term comes from the Latin words modo = road and ernus = current. Modern is a way of life that is oriented to cultural values and oriented towards life in today's world civilization (Fadlatunnisa 2022). Modernity is relatively free from the power of old ways because it has experienced changes in the development of modern times. These changes occur as a result of the influence of outside cultural influences that bring progress, especially in the field of science and technology.
